- Aggie Square Community Partnership
 - [Aggie Square Community Fund](#) is now accepting applications
 - Focus Areas: Youth Opportunities, Workforce Development, Entrepreneurial Support, and Public Art & Placemaking
 - Spark Grants: \$5,000 - \$50,000 for early-stage ideas or pilot projects
 - Impact Grants: \$10,00 - \$50,000 for established programs or collaborations with measurable outcomes
 - Open to nonprofits, artists, and community partners working within Aggie Square neighborhoods
 - **Extended** Application deadline: March 1, 2026
 - Grants awarded: April 2026
- Garden Tour – May 3, 2026 10am – 3pm
 - Seeking hosts – can be any type of garden (finished, work in progress, etc)
 - Mayor Pro Tem Eric Guerra is helping with permits
 - Next month a call for volunteers will go out
 - Proposed Budget: \$1,300
