Committee Updates

 - Ticket prices are lowering to \$5

- Funding Request: \$1,000 without having to payback to CHNA, any net proceeds will go back to CHNA
 - Preliminary budget submitted and reviewed
 - Amy motioned to adopt the new Guidelines. Sarah seconded. Motion passed with no Nay's or Abstention.
- Finance/Treasury
 - December Starting Balance: \$3,667.29
 - Income
 - \$750: Final portion of SMUD sponsorship (National Night Out & Parkfest)
 - \$550: Mayor's Office for Park Closet refresh
 - \$2,000: SMUD 2025 Agreement
 - No Expenses
 - December/Year End Balance: \$6,967.29
 - Jilzy motioned for a one-time approval for purchasing discretion in order to conduct CHNA business during 2025 (i.e. cost of printing monthly flyers, social hour at monthly meetings, etc.). Sarah seconded. Motion passed with no Nay's or Abstention.
- Bike Club (CHBC)
 - Monthly rides every 3rd Sunday, meet at the park and decide where to go
 - January ride will likely be cancelled, and rides will resume in February

 - At an upcoming committee meeting, they will set goals for 2025
