Police, Library, Government Representatives Update

- Councilmember Eric Guerra
 - Searching for a new City Manager
 - Will connect with Sacramento neighborhoods to ask what they want to see in the City Manager
 - Library
 - An assessment identified more issues (unrelated to the fire) that need to be fixed/updated causing the opening to be further delayed
 - Preservation of San Fransisco Blvd
 - Scope: Stockton Blvd to 55th St
 - Has been added to the City of Sacramento Preservation
 Commission for review. If approved, will go to City Council for final approval.
 - o Pools
 - Pools generally open in June
 - Hours/locations/service could be affected due to the City's budget deficit

- o 21st Ave Median
 - Pilot project by 79th St using drought tolerant grass, seeking to see how the grass will hold up during various seasons and with watering limitations
- o 9th Ave Housing
 - 70% income restricted housing, 120 units
- Sac Police Department, Captain James Harrington
 - January 30th incident was a human tracking operation. A police officer was injured causing a much bigger response than usual to the situation.

 - Host interest survey went out to neighbors on the February CHNA flyer, also posted on social media channels
- Bike Club (CHBC)
 - Monthly rides every 3rd Sunday, meet at the park and decide where to go
- Colonial Park

 - One tree will be removed
 - Looking to add more trees and prioritizing native trees
